Consignor Information Sheet

1. PRIVATE SALES COMMONLY REFERED TO AS "ALLEY SALES" ARE NOT PERMITTED PRIOR TO THE SALE!
Every owner has entered into a contract to sell each horse cataloged at auction. This authority is irrevocable, thus no horse may be sold privately before it is offered publically. If a horse is "passed-out" in the auction arena, the private sale of that horse is encouraged provided all settlements are made directly to Jack Auction Group and will be handled the same way as it was sold through the ring.
2. Required Paperwork: copy of registration papers transferred into current seller's name with signed transfer, and payment made out to Jack Auction Group must be received by the deadline, before the entry will be published in the catalog.
No Exceptions! Grade Horses: please provide as much information as possible for the catalog.
3. Dress Code: It is suggested that proper western attire be worn while selling each horse. No Ball Caps! Professionalism towards all customers, staff, and your fellow consignors must be upheld at all times.
All Consignors must conduct themselves with a level of horsemanship that will be acceptable to the general public.
4. Substitutes will be allowed with a vet release of original entry.
No refunds will be given on fees paid on horses not at the sale once they have been catalogued.
5. Mandatory check in from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Friday night or 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Saturday morning.
Please bring your manifest filled out correctly. Your manifest is a legal document and we will pay exactly the name and address on the manifest. All horses will be subject to Brand Inspection and will also pay Hartford Insurance.
6. Sales Horses will have a Lot Number affixed to the horse at all times.
7. Please bring your own horse feed, one bag of shavings will be provided. **NO STRAW ALLOWED!**
8. PREVIEW: Fresh cattle will be available for use during the previews in Saskatoon only! There will be no charge for any requested cattle but, they must be booked at time of entry. Each horse will have approx. 6 Minutes in the arena during the Preview.
9. All ridden or led horses must be left with a halter and lead for the buyer.
10. Only Horses consigned to the sale will be allowed on the premises.
11. Jack Auction Group reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry. If an entry arrives lame or in poor condition, the entry will be turned away and will forfeit his/her entry fee. All decisions made by Jack Auction Group will be final.
